

## City of Rockwall May 6, 2017 General Election

The City of Rockwall has called a General Election to be held on May 6, 2017 for the purpose of electing the Mayor and three City Council Members - one each for Places 1, 3 and 5. Terms for Rockwall City Council Members are for a period of two years.

Friday, February 17<sup>th</sup> marked the last day that candidates could file to run for elective office. The following candidates will appear on the May 6 ballot:
