On the ballot: City Council Places 2, 4, and 6

The First Day to File for a Place on the General Election Ballot will be Wednesday, January 15, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.

The Last Day to File for a Place on the General Election Ballot will be Friday, February 14, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

Candidate filings are submitted to the Rockwall City Secretary on the 3rd floor of City Hall (see address below).

Candidate Eligibility

City Charter Sec. 5.02. - Filing for office [qualifications of candidates.]

- (1) Candidates for City offices must file for office in accordance with the Texas Election Code.
- (2) Candidates for elective City office must meet the following qualifications:
 - (a) Must be at least twenty-one years of age at the time of the election for which they are filing.
 - (b) Must be a qualified voter.
 - (c) Must have resided within the corporate limits of the City, or recently annexed territory, for at least twelve months prior to the filing deadline.
 - (d) Must not, after notice of any delinquency, be in arrears in payment of taxes or other liabilities due the City.
 - (e) No candidate may file in a single election for more than one office or position as provided by this Charter.

About the Rockwall City Council

Rockwall City Council members serve 'at large,' which essentially means that the mayor and all six council members represent all constituents / voters within the city. Although no districts exist, for purposes of the ballot, each council member is elected to a specific place number. Current members of the Rockwall City Council include the following:

The Mayor and Council Members serving in Places 1, 3, and 5 are up for election in odd numbered years, while Places 2, 4, and 6 appear on the ballot in even numbered years. Per the city's charter, council members may serve a total of three, two-year terms (6 consecutive years) before becoming "termed out," having to sit out for one, full year before running again. Thereafter, he or she may be reelected to begin serving additional, two-year terms (again, up to a maximum of three, two-year terms or six, consecutive years).
