City of Rockwall Vehicle/Trailer Damage from Hailstorm Repair Qualifications

SCOPE OF WORK

Contractor to provide all Labor, Materials, Equipment, Supervision and Facility to make hail damage repairs to the 129 vehicles and trailers as referenced on the attached list provided by the City's insurance company adjuster.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is to obtain the necessary information for the City of Rockwall to identify, evaluate and contract with qualified professional companies that specialize in vehicle dent/body damage and paint repairs.

INSTRUCTION FOR SUBMISSION

Selection of a company(s) will be based on the City of Rockwall consultant selection team's evaluation of the submittals related to the company's resources, experience and qualifications to provide these services. One copy of the qualification submittal, limited to five (5) pages, shall be submitted to the City's Purchasing Agent, City of Rockwall, 385 S. Goliad, Rockwall, Texas 75087 no later than 10:00 A.M. on August 27, 2018.

A short list of companies may be selected to work with the City in making all of the vehicle and trailer repairs. After selection of these companies, and verification that the companies comply with State and Federal Regulations, the City and the selected companies will negotiate a scope of services, project schedule and a fee structure for those services. The City reserves the right to reject any or all submittals and discontinue this process without any obligation or liability to any potential respondent.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Approximately 129 City owned vehicles and trailers received damage from a recent hailstorm. Damage estimates vary from \$650 to \$11,300. Total cost of repairs estimated at \$364,000. It is the City's intent to use this RFQ to determine the body shops that receive contracts to make these repairs. Some of the lesser repairs could be done on site at the City's Service Center and then the remaining vehicles with greater amount of damage (needing paint and body repairs) taken to the company's shop or garage to make these repairs. The bidder must have the necessary Manufacturer's certification and/or license to make these repairs as to not void any present or future vehicle equipment, material and/or labor warranties.

- 2. Contractor shall use the vehicles and trailers identified in Exhibit "A" (insurance adjuster report) in preparing his RFQ response.
- 3. Contractor shall explain how they will manage the repair process of these 129 vehicles and trailers or a portion of that fleet.
- 4. Contractor shall provide information concerning their garage/repair facility capabilities for storage and safety of City vehicles and trailers while in the contractor's care, custody and control.
- 5. Contractor shall address the pickup from and delivery to the City for vehicles and trailers that require off site repairs.
- 6. With the City's written permission, the contractors selected has the right and/or option to write and submit a supplemental claim to the City of Rockwall's insurance carrier for any additional loss and damage that may be discovered while completing the repairs.

REQUIREMENTS

Executive Summary

Provide an executive summary of your company's response to this RFQ. The company should prepare a narrative description of the company's experience in vehicle body repairs. This summary should identify the primary benefits to the City of Rockwall of retaining your company and your company's commitment to complete the project on time and within the budget. (20 points)

Experience

Provide a list of similar work your company has performed of like services. Be specific and provide examples that closely match in size and scope. Provide contact information with the other municipalities or government agencies that will serve as your company reference for previous repairs.

(25 points)

Qualification of Project Manager and Key Personnel

Provide the names, qualifications and a list of similar work for the Project Manager and key personnel that will perform the work. Provide an organizational chart showing all personnel and sub-contractors specific to this work.

(20 points)

Proposed Schedule

Provide a schedule for the project.

(15 points)

EVALUATION

The City will establish a consultant selection team made up of various City Employees. The selection team will use the company's submittal to score the information above based on the

number of points for each item. The top three to five companies may be given an opportunity to make an oral presentation to the City's consultant selection team. A 20-30 minute presentation should be made by the proposed Project Manager. The Project Manager presentation should focus on the company's qualifications and the project process. The final decision shall be made based on total of the submittal and interview scores. The highest scored companies will be selected to negotiate a final scope of service, schedule and fee. (20 points)

Insurance Requirements:

Contractors performing work on City property or public right-of-way for the City of Rockwall shall provide the City a certificate of insurance evidencing the coverages and coverage provisions identified herein. Contractors shall provide the City evidence that all subcontractors performing work on the project have the same types and amounts of coverages as required herein or that the subcontractors are included under the contractor's policy. The City, at its own discretion, may require a certified copy of the policy. For this particular work, Garage Keepers Insurance is required.

All insurance companies and coverages must be authorized by the Texas Department of Insurance to transact business in the State of Texas and must be acceptable to the City of Rockwall.

Listed below are the types and amounts of insurance required. The City reserves the right to amend or require additional types and amounts of coverages or provisions depending on the nature of the work.

Contractor shall add the City of Rockwall as an additional insured on all required insurance policies, except worker's compensation, employer's liability and errors and

omissions insurance. The Commercial General Liability Policy and Umbrella Liability Policy shall be of an "occurrence" type policy.
